I HIGHLY RECOMMEND THIS COURSE Love this method for learning French Overall, I learned a ton of French with these Audible downloads parts 1 3 before I traveled to Provence this summer If any background at all in French I took 2 years in H.S almost 30 years ago , you will find yourself a little frustrated at times with the slowness of the basics, but first time learners who are totally unfamiliar with French accents will find the pausing and repetition helpful I was able to use a fair amount of what I had learned during my travels it even helped with a sticky rental car situation which proved invaluable for enhancing my vacation experience I highly recommend these I did have to look up several words I wasn't sure of the pronunciation for car audio not the best sound to see how they were spelled, but that didn't happen very often Fair warning, part 3 felt much faster paced to me, so it may need to be listened to than once I would also say that because these are for listening to learn, you don't get the benefit of seeing how the words are spelled most of the time unless Paul spells something for you which is rare and if you are a visual learner a different method or at least an accompanying workbook would be beneficial.
