Great I can't wait to read this book Isabel of Whales was my favorite book for about two and half year and I'm embarrassed about how many times I've reread it think the Harry Potter

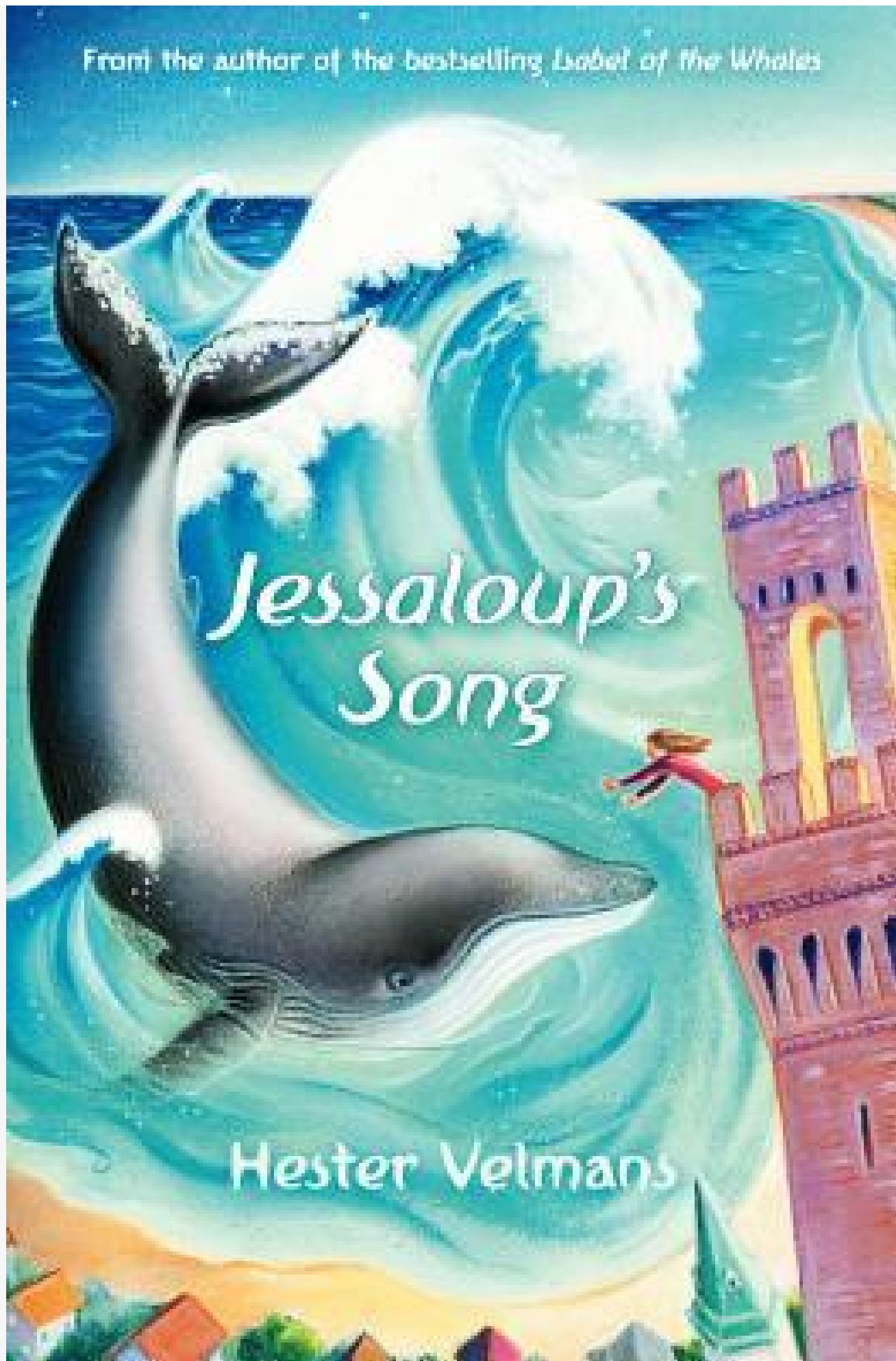
