Individually these stories work well enough Collected together their weaknesses are amplified by repetition too much emphasis on an outsider s perspective of their hosts over exaggerated eccentricities, with Alleyn descending from Olympus in the final act to shed light on the proceedings, and the outsider running off with the fair damsel at the end.Of the three The Dancing Footman works best.
