Amusing Adequate but disappointing Marsh s strength appears to be plots that draw texture from an almost anthropological approach to human temperament, relationships and social groups There may be other books by her that succeed, but in these three, the sketches of the theatre company, the satanic cult druggie fiesta and incestuous gentry in remote parts of England s hinterland she fais to inspire confidence The detective Alleyn in contrast is flat and strangely uninspiring, though obviously competent In addition the books have dated perceptively perhaps because of the close reading of class, race and other sociological artefacts, where the attempt to explore them seem clumsy and ill expressed Marsh s greatest facility is in the creation of a brooding suspense, casting a shadow across all of the characters, something that doesn t quite leave even after the denouement.
